## Father Paddy's Corner

Because of the Coronavirus, the daily mass and mass intention is always for the day ahead so that it can be recorded and posted on the internet.

We are now holding regular weekend and weekday masses. Below are guidelines from the Bishop which we have already begun implementing: You are still dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass.

- Social distancing guidelines must be followed.
- The Body of Christ will be given, but the Blood of Christ may NOT be given. Communion will be brought to you in your seat. Communion may NOT be received on the tongue.
- The baskets will not be passed.
- There should be liberal and conspicuous use of hand sanitizer.
- Masks are strongly encouraged for use by the congregation, the Eucharistic Ministers and ushers. Children under the age of 2 do not have to wear a mask. We will have some masks available, but please bring your own if you have one.
- No Missalettes or hymnals are allowed, and bulletins are not to be passed out.
- No hand shaking or hugging at the sign of peace.
- There will be no altar servers.
- No gathering in crowds before or after Mass.
- Parents with children, please be sure they do not roam. Please have them stay in their seat, on your lap, or stand next to your chair.

Chairs are set up in the church 6 feet apart in sets of one, two, three & four (to accommodate families). Inside seating will be first come first served, and we cannot reserve seating, except, for the ministers at that Mass. We have installed outdoor speakers and the overflow will be seated outside.
