All of Diamondhead, all of the Oaks, Stable wood, Lazy Acres, Ladner Town, DeLisle, Dubuison and Rotten Bayou are part of Most Holy Trinity Parish. The Catholic Church has universal structure of Dioceses and parishes. Most parishes are territorial.

FOR THE HARD OF HEARING - An assistive listening device has been installed in our sound system thanks to the generosity of a parishioner. If you have trouble hearing or understanding what is being said at mass, all you need is a small FM radio with ear buds. Tune the radio to FM 91.1 to access the system. The ushers may have a radio available to borrow during mass, or you may wish to bring your own.

RADIO BROADCAST MASS - You can listen to mass in the parking lot from your car. Pull into the lot, tune your car radio to FM 91.1 and hear the Mass live from inside the church. If you would like communion, please get out of your car, and walk to either the front or side door of the church and a Eucharistic Minister will come to you. If you are inside the church, all you need is a small FM radio with ear buds. Tune your radio to FM 91.1 to access the system.

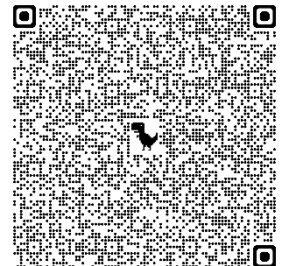
